Peninsula Flyers EAA Chapter 630 Scholarships

Interested in an aviation career? Would you be interested in receiving money to help finance your college education?

Each year the Peninsula Flyers Incorporated, a chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association, offers scholarships to high school seniors interested in pursuing a career in aviation. These scholarships and awards are offered to well rounded individuals involved in school and community activities as well as aviation. The academic record of applicants should verify the ability to successfully complete the educational activity for which they are requesting the scholarship.

Why seek a career in aviation?

According to recent research the aviation industry will hire more than 50,000 new people in the next 10 years. There are many different occupational opportunities within aviation. These include not only pilots, flight attendants, and mechanics but also airport support and management personnel, air traffic controllers and many other administrative positions.

Why seek higher education for a career in aviation?

A recent Department of Transportation study concluded that there will continue to be plenty of pilots who meet the FAA minimum requirements for commercial ratings, but it is unlikely that enough of these pilots will have the proper computer, human factors and aeromedical skills to operate increasingly sophisticated equipment. These same training requirements apply to non-pilot positions as well.

Aviation scholarship are granted to outstanding High School Juniors and Seniors with a G.P.A. of at least 3.0 on a 4 point scale who intend to major in an aviation related career.

Along with your application, you **must** include two reference letters and an applicant's statement.
